● The National Environmental Policy Act

- Promotes efforts to prevent or eliminate damage to the environment
- Goal to protect and foster the human environment through well-informed federal decisions
- Includes preparation of a NEPA document and public review/comment process

● Federal agencies:

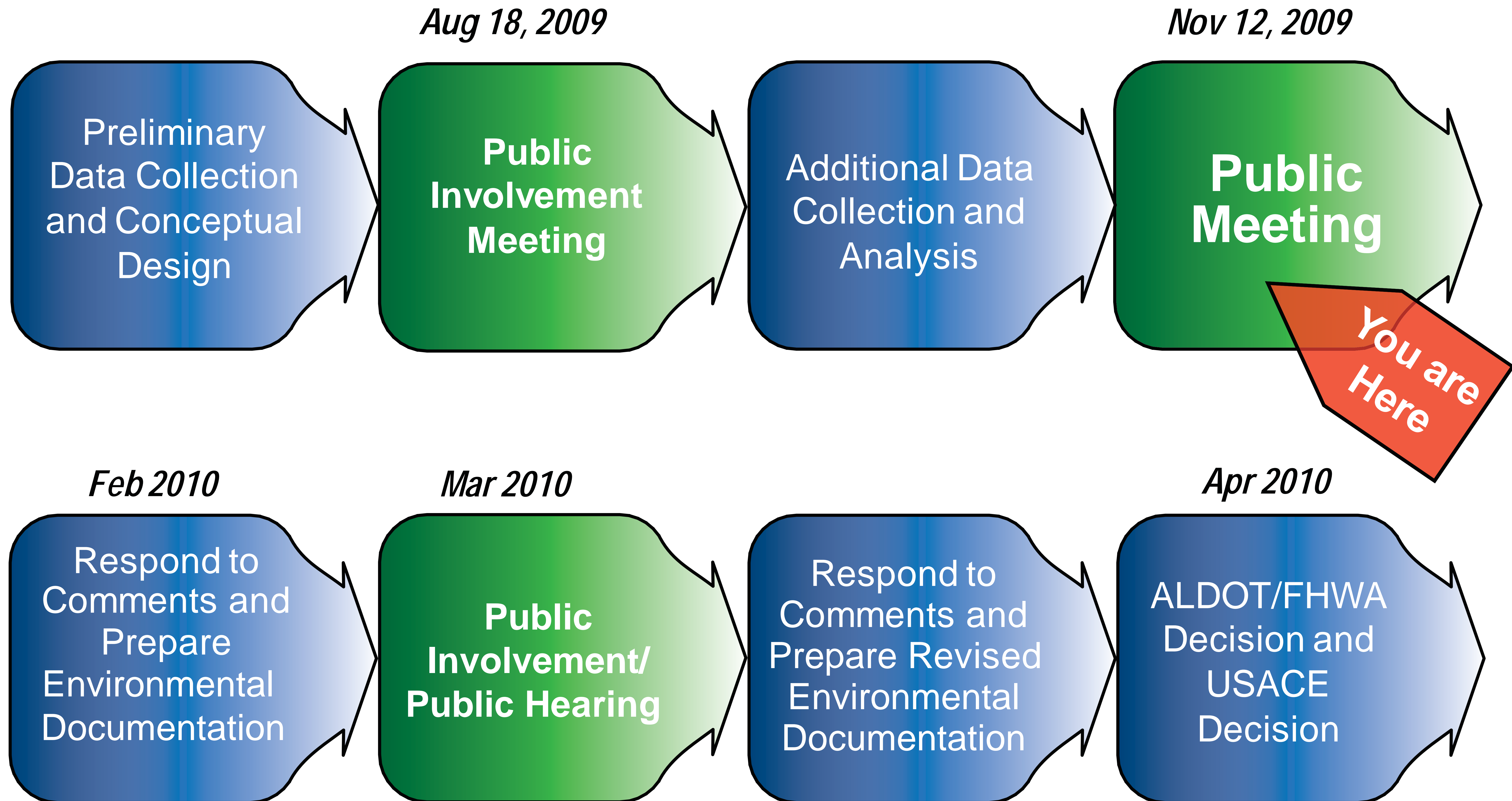
- Consider reasonable environmental impacts of proposed actions and reasonable and feasible alternatives
- Integrate environmental values into decision making process
